- Our organization did not quality for Tax Exempt Status so we are dropping future attempts.

- Vickie wrote an engaging report for Synod Assembly and was offered three minutes to address the assembly with an invitation to the upcoming WELCA convention in July.

- Rev. Kim Frederking will be the convention chaplain on Friday and Saturday only.

 up with someone while leaving worship. Kathy R. will help facilitate.
