Purpose according to Constitution

Purpose: *C4.01. The Church is a people created by God in Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit, called and sent to bear witness to God's creative, redeeming, and sanctifying activity in the world.



Purpose according to Constitution

Purpose: *C4.02. To participate in God's mission, this congregation as a part of the Church shall:

- a. Worship God in proclamation of the Word and administration of the sacraments and through lives of prayer, praise, thanksgiving, witness, and service.
- b. Proclaim God's saving Gospel of justification by grace for Christ's sake through faith alone, according to the apostolic witness in the Holy Scripture, preserving and transmitting the Gospel faithfully to future generations.
- c. Carry out Christ's Great Commission by *reaching out to all people* to bring them to faith in Christ and by doing all ministry with a global awareness consistent with the understanding of God as Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier of all.



Purpose according to Constitution

Purpose:

- d. Serve in response to God's love to meet human needs, caring for the sick and the aged, advocating dignity and justice for all people, working for peace and reconciliation among the nations, standing with the poor and powerless, and committing itself to their needs.
- e. *Nurture its members* in the Word of God so as to grow in faith and hope and love, to see daily life as the primary setting for the exercise of their Christian calling, and to use the gifts of the Spirit for their life together and for their calling in the world.
- f. *Manifest the unity* given to the people of God by living together in the love of Christ and by joining with other Christians in prayer and action to express and preserve the unity which the Spirit gives.

Provides the reason/reasons that you exist

 - not goals/strategies as these will change
 - Connects every member of the organization with those call to serve
 - Purpose should be at hte core of your guiding statements
 - In the church, our purpose should be God-centered
 - God's calling for the congregation

Purpose is different from Mission

- Mission is how we bring our purpose to life
- Defines your unique ministry
- What you do & for whom

Purpose is different from Vision

Vision describes the desired future position of the organization
